## **South Garden Estates Neighborhood Reconstruction**

Dear Resident,

Wednesday, crews will continue work on your new concrete aprons and driveways on West Shore Drive and Belvidere Lane. Once this is complete, they will move on to Andover Road. You may see a string line and pins across your driveway. Crews use this string line to set line and grade for the curb machine. If you encounter this string line across your driveway, and need to move your car out, please contact the crews. They will lower the line for you while you move your car out. You may need to park down the street to stay out of the crews way. Crews intend to install the curb and gutter first, then do the concrete driveways and aprons. You will be notified by an orange flyer in your front door. This flyer will have instructions on where to park your car, and contain information on the 7-day curing period for the new concrete. Please watch your front door. Crews will place this a day in advance to keep you informed of where/when to move your car out.

Wednesday, crews will also be working on West Shore Drive installing the rest of the storm sewer. They will have the roadway closed from W. 70<sup>th</sup> St. to Andover Road while this work is being done.

Thursday, crews will be shutting off the water on Belvidere to install 2 new fire hydrants. An orange tag will be placed on your door a day in advance of the shutdown. Shut downs will not begin until after 8:00 am. Crews will have the water on as soon as they possibly can. This should be the last of the water shut downs in the neighborhood.

Later next week, crews will be doing some asphalt driveways in areas where the roadway has been paved in. Crews will also be working on shaping the gravel roadway surface on Belvidere and West Shore Drive, and backfilling behind the new curb and gutter.

Please use Wooddale, as it will be your best access in and out of the neighborhood next week.

Please remind all children to stay away from all reconstruction operations, parked equipment, and stockpiled supplies. For everyone's safety, if you see anything onsite that looks out of place or someone that doesn't belong please call the City of Edina Police Dept. They have been informed of this, and are keeping a close eye on the site for us, but your help would be greatly appreciated if you see anything out of place.

***Please remember this schedule is weather dependent and therefore, can change on a daily basis.*** As always, please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.
